Indian English is a group of English dialect spoken in many states, and even became the official language of the some states in republic Dominion of India (Berns and de Bot 2005) ^[4]. After independence from British the Republic of India in 1947 used English for communication. According to one survey less than 0.1 percent of Indians comprised of few hundred thousand people speak English as their regular language. Whileas, more than 30% of Indians communicate in some English. (Chelliah 2001) ^[5]. In another report, more than 12.18% of Indian citizens speak English in addition to their own language (Driessen *et al.*, 1989) ^[7].

Nearly, 200 thousand people have their language as English as their first language. Whileas, for 86 million people it is their second language (Driessen *et al.* 2000) ^[8]. For rest of 39 million people English is their 3rd language, used not regularly compared to first language

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speakers. It is found that a collection of English dialects commonly called as Indian English (IE) is spoken everywhere and throughout in the India and among the Indian Diaspora (British reside in India). The Indian constitution is very well versed and rich and accordingly permitted for using both Hindi and English for communication in office as well in international matters (Edward 2012; Extra, G and Gorter 2001) [9, 10]. In India, the English is considered as second official language in many states, and in one union territory. Further, English is used as an official language in seven states and seven union territories in India, in addition to their local language (Hindi) and Urdu (Fishman 2001) [11]. Further, it is mandatory that the state governor or legislature mandates and permits for the use of a regional language. Further, the President of India approves the use of local, regional, or some burrowed languages in courts. However, the English is the only official language of the Indian judiciary, which is especially due to British influence in post-independence era which has got inherited in judiciary (Gombos 2002) [13].

As per Government Information Service (Barbados) GIS (2009) [14] among all Europe Sovereign states, only Puerto Rico employs a language other than English. Thus the principle and main working language of the Puerto Rico is Spanish. Despite the fact that English is not de jure an official language at the national level in the United States. In Indian, the English is the official language in the many of states and territories within the country and its influence is increasing and in future more sates are moving towards same (Hicks 2003) [15]. In world the English is the most extensively and widely used foreign language, first and foremost, with greater number of people involved as well as largest amount of data available (Teunissen 1986) [15]. The large mass of literature is widely communicated and written and published in English, which means that it is widely accepted, used and written as a common language by speakers from different non-speaking nations such as Sri-Lanka, Brazil and Middle Eastern nations.
